Engineering Explorer Post 827 has provided information on careers in engineering, architecture, and the sciences to young women and men ages 14 to 20 for five years. The post meets Tuesday evenings from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. for six consecutive weeks beginning the first Tuesday in January. Meeting locations are different each week depending on the host of that week's topic. Examples of prior year programs include:

- Astronautics/Aerospace (with astronaut speaker) sponsored by Lockheed Martin
- Transportation Engineering (with tour of CDOT Traffic Mgt. Center) sponsored by CDOT
- Micro-Biology (with tour of micro-biology and energy laboratories) sponsored by the Colorado School of Mines
- Construction Management (with tour of the Chatfield Dam gate house) sponsored by the Corps. of Engineers
- Industrial Engineering (with tour of VESTAS wind turbine manufacturing facility)
- Nuclear Engineering sponsored by the Shaw Group (now CB&I)

Transportation to/from meetings is the responsibility of the student/parents. The cost for the program is \$24 which covers registration with BSA. All other program costs are covered by the Society of American Military Engineers. The program is limited to 33 youth annually. Sign up is on a first come first served basis.
