

# COUT DAY CAM

Cub Scout Day Camps are multi-day theme-based programs that are age appropriate for Tiger Cubs and their adult partners, Cub Scout and Webelos Scouts. Day Camp participants will experience fun and exciting adventures while working on advancement. Trained volunteer leaders and parents from the district conduct Day Camp under the direction of Council leadership. All Day Camps are held at approved community sites during the day or early evening hours and do not include overnight activities.

Participants can attend Day Camp with their Cub Pack or den as well as an individual Scout with a parent. Tiger Cubs must attend with an adult partner. In addition to an exciting, age appropriate program, each Scout will receive a t-shirt, hat, water bottle and a patch.

### MINI CAMP

A Mini Camp program is offered for potty trained siblings under the age of 10 at most Day Camp locations. Fees vary from site to site and are collected upon arrival. Parents/guardians of Mini Camp participants must be in camp each day their child attends Mini Camp.

## ADVENTURE CAMP

Located at Peaceful Valley Scout Ranch in Elbert Colorado, Magness Adventure Camp introduces boys to the fun and adventure of Scouting in the outdoors under the guidance of Magness' full-time trained camp staff in 12, three-day, two night sessions.

Scouts spend their days hiking through the Ponderosa Pines in the Black Forest, canoeing and fishing on the lake and shooting BB guns, all while gaining rank advancement and working on skills that will help them both in and out of Scouting.
